Kris asked if Town website now shows that the survey was modified from a sample survey originally published on DOLA's website, and was not paid for by any Town funds. Beth will check website and get info to Mayor if need be.

Meeting Structure:

There was a short discussion over whether we should have a public comment period at N2N meetings. Neighbors may bring concerns to N2N Team members at any time. No change was proposed.

Current State Statement:

A new Current State statement was read. There was brief discussion. No changes were recommended. Joanne moved to approve. Kris seconded. Approved 5-0.

Current code enforcement process has an 80% compliance rate. Some residents are upset about historic violations that have not been brought into compliance. Some residents are upset about new changes to the code enforcement process. The N2N Team meetings have experienced significant disruptions as a result. The Mayor has asked the N2N Team to focus on improving the code enforcement process by recommending solutions acceptable to the majority of the residents and salable to the Board of Trustees. The Mayor fully supports the N2N Team.
