Whereas the town of Williamsburg's (the town) codes in chapter 7 concerning 7-104 Dogs at large and nuisance destructive and dangerous dogs.

Whereas the town has a history, both past and present, of these codes being violated -

Whereas it is the town's intention to provide for the present and future safety of its residents, the town's ability to identify violators and the town's ability to enforce the aforementioned codes in a timely manner, the following Is added to chapter 7 of the town's codes.

Chapter 7-108-Dog Identification

1 John Street, Williamsburg, CO

8/19/25 - Introduced, read & X on first reading

- (a) Owners of dogs that reside in Williamsburg shall, at no charge, provide to the town, via hardcopy or electronically, the following information; A clear picture of the dog, the dog's breed, gender, spayed/neutered, approximate age, the dog's name and address and the owner's name, address and contact information.
- (b) For the life of the dog, or until notification that the dog no longer resides in Williamsburg, the town shall retain said information in a confidential file for investigative purposes of any of the aforementioned Chapter 7 violations.
- (c) Failure to comply may result in a fine stated in a separate ordinance
- (d) To ensure the safety of the town's residents, upon a majority board approval of the first reading, a copy of this ordinance shall be sent via USPS to all the town's residents and shall become both effective and enforceable 10 days following such mailing.
