1. Under these conditions the tap is considered reserved. The tap is not considered sold until the meter is installed.

An application and acquisition of a new tap would be subject to the following conditions:

- 2. The cost of the tap would reflect the current cost of materials and labor to install the meter, and the current minimal regional rate.
 - 3. Within 120 days (4 months) after the application fee is paid, the tap must be purchased.
 - 4. After an additional 90 days the tap must be installed.
- 5. If the tap is not installed within the 90 days after purchase, the tap reverts back to the Town. A refund of 1/2 of the tap cost would be made. The remaining 1/2 would go into the Systems Development fund.
 - 5. Under these conditions, the tap payment would not be made to Florence until the tap is installed.

**In addition, passage of this resolution does not limit or prevent arrangements from being made for special situations.
